01. EVANGELISM

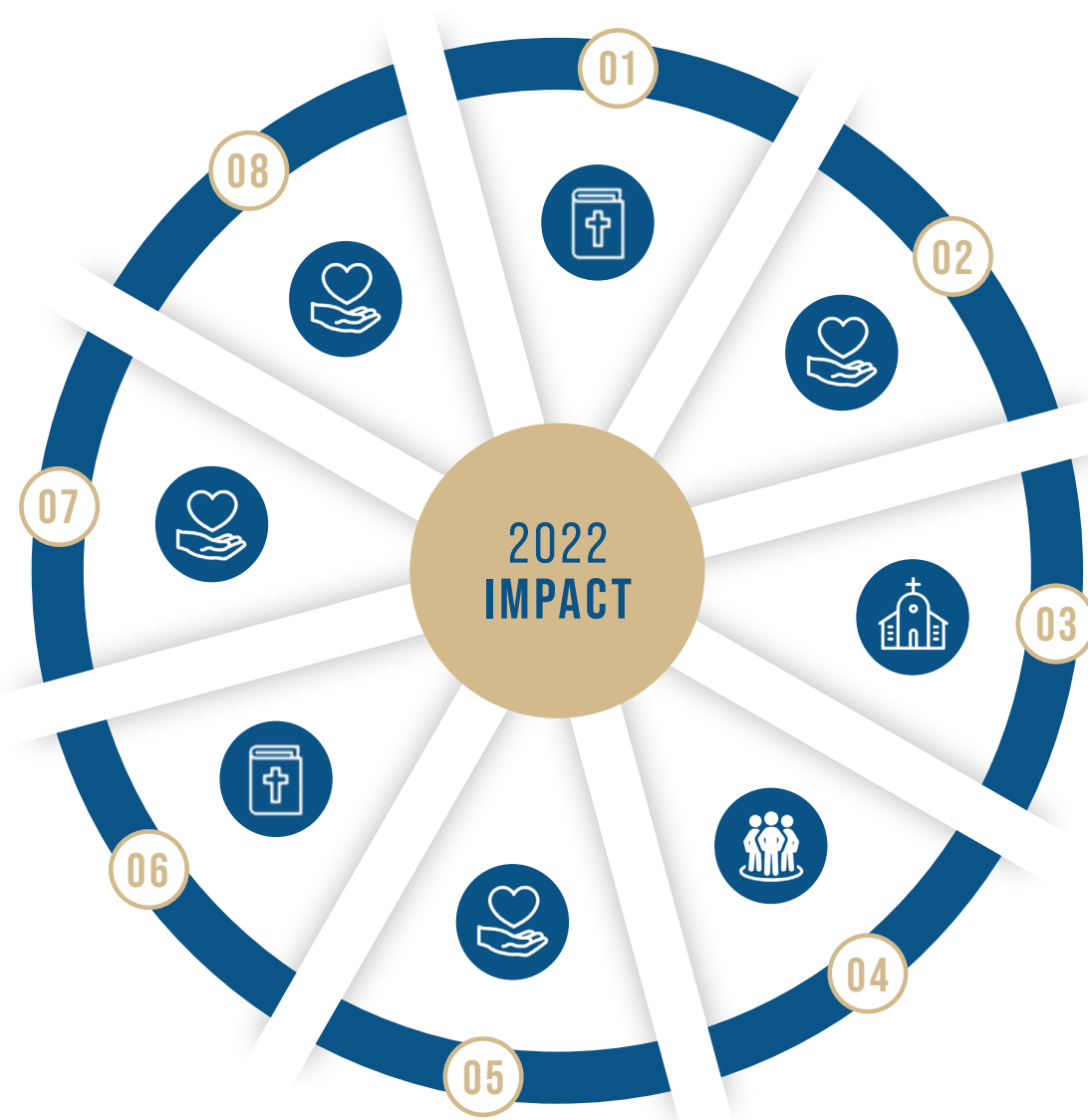
- Two audio recordings of the New Testament were completed which will allow approximately 390,000 people to hear God’s Word in their heart language.
- Supported the creation of content to reach millennials and the Z Generation resulting in 5,336 professions of faith from June 11-December 15, 2022.
- Increased access to the I Found the Truth testimonies of former Muslims that now follow Jesus.
- Syria - 80 new believers baptized from Sunni Muslims, Shia Muslims, Ishmaelites, Druze, and Alawites. Ministering to over 2,500 orphan children most from Muslim background. Approximately 200 children came to faith in Christ, most from Sunni Muslim background.
- India - 7,402 Leaders Trained, 1,631 Bible Story Groups Started, 15,328 People Reached with the Gospel, 1,090 Believers Baptized.

02. PRISON MINISTRY

- Provided a donation to CHARM Prison Ministry whose mission is to bring the hope found only in Jesus Christ to incarcerated men and women, correctional personnel, and their respective families.

03. PASTORAL TRAINING & CHURCH PLANTING

- Ukraine - Provided support to pastors, for church strengthening, and to youth and adults who lost family members.
- Support for the rebuilding of the Underground Church in Afghanistan.
- Support provided for pastoral training materials to be translated into new languages to expand ministry impact.
- Support to train fathers, pastors, and leaders on Biblical Fatherhood in Ecuador, Mexico, Cuba, Spain, the Dominican Republic, and in seven African Countries.
- Supported expansion of ministry toward the multi-year goal to make theological education accessible to every ministry leader in the world.
- Supported ministry work in East Africa - 2,364 Churches started, 307,675 people reached with the gospel, 123,055 people who now follow Jesus, 10,024 small group Bible studies meeting, and 50,254 people attending Bible studies.
- India - 156 Churches Planted



04. SPIRITUAL MENTORSHIP/LEADERSHIP

- 932 men and women received spiritual mentoring in the United States and Mexico (May 2018 to December 2022)
- Funded three positions (Educational Instructor III, Biblical Counselor and Children’s Minister) at Star of Hope to serve homeless men, women, and their children
- Supported spiritual leadership training for marketplace men.
- Supported leadership training in Afghanistan that teaches biblical truth.

05. PROTECTING THE UNBORN

- Supported Project Arrow which saves babies by providing marketing support to pro-life clinics to reach abortion seeking women with a pro-life alternative in the Houston and DFW areas. 342 babies were saved in the Houston area and 309 babies were saved in the DFW area.

06. RELIGIOUS LIBERTY

- Support for Restoring Faith in America Project building on the historic Supreme Court victory in Kennedy v. Bremerton School District to transform public expression of faith in communities throughout America.

07. COMMUNITY TRANSFORMATION

- Provided a donation to support the purchase of a van to support ministry for those living in the OST-Union neighborhood of Houston.
- Support for the drilling of a water well for people in need in Africa.
- Support for enhanced ministry to mentor, disciple, and serve at-risk youth and their families.

08. CRISIS RESPONSE

- Supported emergency relief efforts in the name of Jesus for the devastating flood in Eastern Kentucky.
- Provided humanitarian aid and support for rescues of women and their families from heavy war areas in Ukraine.
- Provided support for families that were impacted by the Shadowdale Apartment fire in Houston
- Support for Syrian orphans and widows in the name of Jesus who have been devastated by the 10-year war.



## \$307,625 - UNCHARTED MINISTRIES

The donation was for the First Response Initiative for Ukraine (\$131,625), the Underground Church in Afghanistan (\$51,000), support for Syrian orphans and widows (\$110,000), and for Uncharted staff members (\$15,000). The mission of Uncharted Ministries is "Reaching the Unreached and Standing with the Persecuted".



## \$180,200 - MULTIPLICATION NETWORK

The donation was for church planter training to reach Nigeria and West Africa, the 2022 and 2023 budget for the Multiplication Network (MN) East Africa Hub training church planters in twenty-one countries, and for a trip to Tanzania to visit church plants. MN is a church planting/strengthening ministry with global impact.



## \$175,000 - STAR OF HOPE

The donation was for the hiring of an Educational Instructor II position, a Biblical Counselor position, and a Children's Minister position for older children. Star of Hope is a Christ-centered community dedicated to meeting the needs of homeless men, women, and their children.



## \$165,500 - PRE-BORN

The donation was for Project Arrow in the Dallas-Fort Worth (\$50,000) and Houston areas (\$110,500). The donations will provide marketing support for pro-life clinics. The mission of Pre-Born is to glorify Jesus Christ by leading and equipping pregnancy clinics to save more babies and souls.



## \$165,000 - WORLD HOPE MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL

The donation was for the heart language project for translation of curriculum, and in support of the Accelerated Growth Initiative to expand the reach of the ministry. WHMI works in 45 countries to Train Pastors, Grow Churches, and Transform Communities.



## \$147,000 - FOR ALL MANKIND MOVEMENT

The donation was for the Bihar, India Movement and for continued ministry work in six states in Northern India. FAMB exists to initiate, nurture, and facilitate disciple-making movements which result in biblical church planting among the unreached.



## \$146,080 - ABIDING FATHERS

The donation was for assistance for a pastor in Cuba to purchase a home, and for 2022 and 2023 Abiding Fathers and Padre Corazon Projects to teach Biblical Fatherhood in Africa, Ecuador, Mexico, Cuba, the Dominican Republic, and Spain.



## \$125,000 - FIRST LIBERTY INSTITUTE

The primary focus of the donation was for the Restoring Faith in America Initiative. First Liberty Institute is the largest legal organization in the nation dedicated exclusively to defending religious liberty for all Americans.



## \$110,000 - I FOUND THE TRUTH

The donation was to increase hits on the website for access to testimonies of former Muslims who have come to Christ, and to support the development of the I Found the Truth Film Documentary.



## \$65,764 - TRUTH OF LIFE MINISTRIES

The donation brings freedom to men and women by applying biblical truth. 932 men and women received spiritual mentoring in the United States and Mexico (May 2018 to December 2022).



## \$55,000 - PROVIDENCE CHURCH-FRISCO, TX

The donation was for the Providence Church Entrusted and Sent Capital Campaign, and for the general operating budget.



## \$50,000 - GROUNDWIRE

The donation was for the development of the "Do I Matter" site to deliver the Gospel to Millennials and the Z Generation.



## \$40,000 - THE FINISHING FUND

The donation supports missionaries who are taking the gospel to people groups that have yet to hear the good news of salvation in Jesus Christ.



## \$35,000 - FAITH COMES BY HEARING

The donation was for the audio recording of the New Testament in the Kambura language and with matching funds, an audio recording of the New Testament in the Ndokwa language. These audio recordings will provide God's Word in the heart language of approximately 390,000 people.



## \$20,500 - CHARM PRISON MINISTRY

This was a general donation to CHARM Prison Ministry whose mission is to bring hope found only in Jesus Christ to incarcerated men and women, correctional personnel, and their respective families.



## \$15,100 - THE MASTER'S PROGRAM

The donation was for general use and to support Master's Program tuition for two DMRE employees. The Master's Program prepares Christian leaders and marketplace Christian leaders to change their world and build God's Kingdom.



## \$11,500 - CHAPELWOOD UNITED METHODIST CHURCH YEAR-ROUND FAMILY PROGRAM

The donation was in support of people displaced by the Shadowdale Apartment fire in December of 2021 and for the Chapelwood Foundation Clay Shoot.



## \$10,000 - AGAPE DEVELOPMENT

The donation was to support the purchase of a van to support ministry activities. Agape Development is working to transform their neighborhood by preparing Christ-following, independent community leaders.



## \$10,000 - SAMARITAN'S PURSE

The donation was in support of crisis response in the name of Jesus to the devastating flood in Eastern Kentucky.
