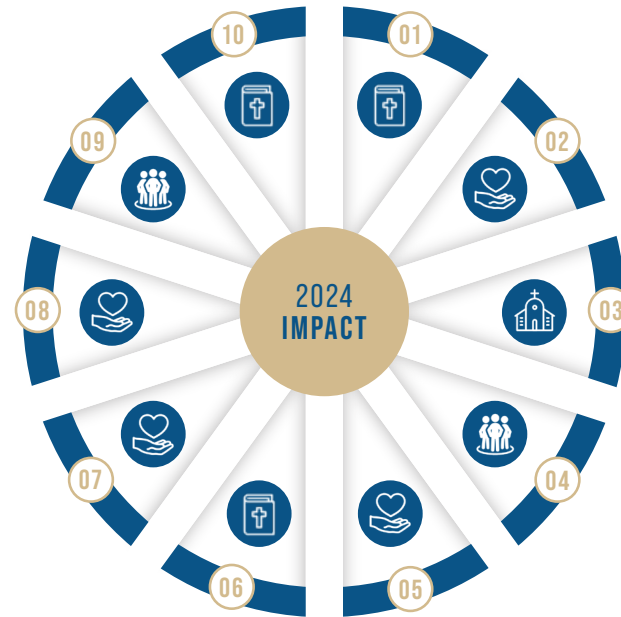
10 CAUSES SUPPORTED IN 2024

01 EVANGELISM

- Four audio recordings of the New Testament were funded which when completed will allow approximately 4,900,000 people to hear God's Word in their heart language.
- Supported the sending of missionaries to people groups around the world that have not yet heard the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- Provided support for the production and promotion of the I Found the Truth Roundtable Series. These films are for seeking Muslims to watch a group of former Muslims share about Jesus.
- Supported approximately nine weeks of radio broadcasting of Abide in the Word throughout Portland and the Eugene/Springfield areas in Oregon.
- Supported 1,225 people coming to faith in Jesus Christ and approximately 166 of those took a meaningful and measured step in their spiritual journey.
- Pakistan – Supported the training of 479 leaders, the starting of 52 Story Groups, 1,643 people reached, 140 Baptisms and 29 churches planted.
- Support for gospel/discipleship programs with Unreached People Groups in Syria.
- Syria – Approximately 200 men and women came to faith in Christ and ministered to approximately 2500 children with many coming to faith in Christ.
- Israel - Supported the ministry to take the gospel to Holocaust Survivors in Israel and the sharing the salvation available only in the Jewish Messiah with thousands of Israelis. Approximately 250 Jews trusted Christ as Savior.
- Support for the sharing of the gospel with four different Israeli Defense Force Battalions.
- Planted gospel seeds in the lives of refugee children in Dallas through the hearing of the story of Christ's birth
- Provided support to Toolbox Ministries with a mission to help men in the marketplace come to know and follow Jesus Christ

02 PASTORAL TRAINING & CHURCH PLANTING

- Provided support for Abiding Fathers Projects to disciple men in understanding their God-given role as a father in Cuba, Ecuador, Panama and Mexico.
- Provided a donation to be used to provide Scholarships for B. H Carroll Seminary Students.
- Supported ministry work in Nepal – 54 Churches started, 2,183 people reached with the gospel, 213 people who now follow Jesus, and 32 people in Small Group Bible studies.
- Supported ministry work in Cambodia – 16 Churches started, 426 People Reached with the Gospel, 143 people who now follow Jesus, and 16 people in Small Group Bible studies.
- Provided funding for the translation for four pastoral training courses in 19 heart languages.
- Provided support which laid the foundation for further expansion of the Romans Project to new countries.
- Provided support for the sending of a missionary couple to Taiwan in 2024 to make mature disciples, establish healthy churches and train local leaders.
- Supported the sending of missionaries to plant churches in areas of the world where there are few churches.



03 SPIRITUAL MENTORSHIP/LEADERSHIP

- Supported ministry where from May 2018 to December 2024 - 1,652 men and women received spiritual mentoring in the U.S. and Mexico (153 individually and 1,499 in 100 Groups)
- Supported the Master's Program with the core mission to develop leaders who will make an eternal impact regardless of cultural conditions.

04 PROTECTING THE UNBORN

- Supported Project Arrow which saves babies by providing marketing support to pro-life clinics to reach abortion seeking women with a pro-life alternative in the Houston and Dallas-Fort Worth areas. **The donation saved 54 lives.**

05 RELIGIOUS LIBERTY

- Support for the Restoring Faith in America Initiative building on the historic Supreme Court victory in Kennedy v. Bremerton School District to transform public expressions of faith in communities throughout America.
- Support for travel to Thailand to work with 100 persecuted Vietnamese Christians and to Iraq to help with 1,500 persecuted Syrian Christians.

06 COMMUNITY TRANSFORMATION

- Support for a University Scholarship Fund in Guatemala to serve vulnerable students served by WOW International – Orphan Outreach.
- Support for the purchase of a van to support ministry in Lebanon and for the expansion of a Medical/Dental space in the Hope Ministry Center in Zahleh, Lebanon.
- Support for Providence Church – Frisco, Texas and Sugar Creek Baptist Church – Sugar Land, Texas.
- Support for theological training of pastors which strengthens churches which in turn transform communities.
- Colombia - Support for eight children and three families, the School Expansion Project, for the expansion of Camp Tenjo to expand ministry including the Family Strengthening Program, and for the purchase of a lot.
- The donation was in support of the Teen Ministry, Young Adult Ministry and for a community space at the Haven of OST in support of the mission of Agape Development to transform their neighborhood by preparing Christ-following, independent, community leaders.
- Supported Christmas celebrations (including food and gifts for students) serving over 120 refugees and their mentors in the Dallas area. Provided 110 new reading and vocabulary workbooks to enhance the student literacy program.
- Provided support to a family-led, gospel centered Christian camp.

07 CRISIS RESPONSE

- Supported emergency relief efforts in the name of Jesus for the Crisis in Sudan, the Tornado devastated Midwest and for the extensive impacts of Hurricane Helene in a multi-state area of the southeastern United States.
- Provided critical food and spiritual aid to Zambian families facing a severe hunger crisis.
- Provided support for the ongoing ministry to Widows and Orphans throughout Syria.

08 HUMAN TRAFFICKING

- Provided support for the Transaction Intercept Program in Texas with strategic goals to remove the cloak of anonymity for buyers of illegal sex, disrupt transactions before they occur, share information and collaborate with local, state, and federal law enforcement, and redirect buyers to resources for help, ultimately reducing the percentage of repeat callers.

09 CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

- A matching donation was provided to West Christian Prep School supporting plans for the school to open later in 2025.

10 SUPPORTING THE HOMELESS

- Provided a warm Holiday Meal to almost 200 individuals. This event established over 50 new relationships with individuals experiencing homelessness for follow-up.
- The donation was for the funding of a Workplace Development Coordinator II Position at Star of Hope. This position served 230 job seekers with employment and transportation services as well as 71 work supports including identification documents, birth certificates, work clothing and shoes.



CONVIVENTIA

The donation was for the School Expansion Construction Project, to provide support for eight children and three families, for the expansion of Camp Tenjo, for two family mission trips and for the purchase of a lot. Conviventia is a Christian development and relief non-profit breaking the cycle of poverty in Colombia by strengthening individuals, families and communities through a broad range of programs based on the principles of faith, empowerment and sustainability.



UNCHARTED MINISTRIES

The donation was in support of Syrian Orphans and Widows from the multi-year war, gospel/discipleship programs with the Unreached People Groups of Syria, sharing of the gospel to Israelis and for support of an Uncharted staff member. The mission of Uncharted Ministries is "Reaching the Unreached and Standing with the Persecuted".



ALL ACCESS INTERNATIONAL

The donation was in support of the All Access Ministry Portfolio, the All Access Annual Fundraiser and to the All Access Overhead Fund. The philosophy of All Access is to fund the most cost-effective programs that best reduce the spiritual and physical poverty levels in the most unreached and impoverished countries in the world.



STAR OF HOPE

The donation was for the funding of a Workplace Development Coordinator II Position, associated work documents and client transportation for employment. Star of Hope is a Christ-centered community dedicated to meeting the needs of homeless men, women, and their children.



MULTIPLICATION NETWORK

The donation was for the 2024 Budget for Church Planter Training in Nepal and for the training of church planters in Cambodia. Multiplication Network is a church planning /strengthening ministry with global impact.



WORLD HOPE MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL

The donation was for the translation of curriculum to support the pastoral training ministry. World Hope Ministry International works in approximately 54 countries to Train Pastors, Grow Churches and Transform Communities.



TRUTH OF LIFE MINISTRIES

The donation brings freedom to men and women by applying biblical truth. 1,652 men and women have received spiritual mentoring in the U.S. and Mexico through this ministry (May 2018 to December 2024).



FRONTLINE RESPONSE

Frontline Response is on the frontlines every day rescuing individuals out of the darkness of sex trafficking and homelessness while preventing children and other vulnerable individuals from falling victim.



FAITH COMES BY HEARING

The donation was for the audio recording of the New Testament in the Maninka language (Guinea) and with matching funds, an audio recording of the New Testament in the Chokwe language (Zambia). In addition, the audio recording of the New Testament in the Mbosi language in the Congo and with matching funds the audio recording of the New Testament for the Sewhi people group in Ghana. When the four audio recordings are completed, approximately 4,900,000 people will be able to hear the New Testament in their heart language.



SAMARITAN'S PURSE

The donation was in support of crisis response in the name of Jesus to support the people in Sudan, the tornado devastated Midwest and for the extensive impacts of Hurricane Helene in a multi-state areas of the southeast. Samaritan's Purse is a non-denominational evangelical Christian organization providing spiritual and physical aid to hurting people around the world.



HEART FOR LEBANON

The donation was to support the purchase of a van to support ministry and for the expansion of the Medical/Dental space in the Hope Ministry Center in Zahleh.
